Glissando- All glissandos should happen just before the note being gliss'd to.




Slide Vibrato- narrow (n.) vibratos should be barely noticed, wide (w.) should be about an eighth tone above and below the notated pitch.




Same Note Glissandos- As with the regular glissando, these should happen just before the note being gliss'd to.



Lip Trills



Sing the letter while playing. In this example, start with A, change to O, then slowly return to normal playing.



Flutter Tongue



Shows cues for specific or all performers.

For ensemble sections, all rhythms and tempos are approximate. In the wind and cello parts, large leaps and difficult passages can be given extra time when needed. The timbre is more important than a strict keeping of tempo and rhythm.
